

### **resident** book review

### THE SPLENDID AND THE VILE

You have probably read all the books you need to read about World War II and Winston Churchill. Even so, you might want to take a look at this one. Published just this February, it's an intimate look at leadership and the squat bulldog of a man who was a master of it. It covers the period from May 1940 to May 1941, when Hitler's troops were rolling almost unopposed across Europe with their Fuhrer's sights set firmly on Great Britain. As the new Prime Minister, Churchill was determined that England would not be brought under the heel of Germany. The problem was that England, like most of Europe, was exhausted and depleted in the aftermath of World War I – the Great War to end all wars.

Knowing that his island country could not stand alone for long under the onslaught, Churchill launched a desperate courtship of Franklin Roosevelt, asking and then begging for help from the United States. However, the United States had also invested heavily in the Great War and was in no mood to enter another one. Roosevelt understood this and knew that to commit any assistance to Churchill would be political suicide. But he also understood that if England fell, the United States would stand alone against a vastly expanded German power. So he wanted to help, but he had to lay some groundwork with Congress before he could make any promises. Meanwhile, Germany began bombing England – softening it up for a later invasion.

This book has so many layers and so many intertwining threads that it's impossible to do justice to any one story in a brief review. You'll read about some of Churchill's idiosyncrasies, like doing much of his state business from his bed (or his bathtub), wandering around in the buff, and, of course, his fondness for cigars and booze. But you'll also read about his genius as a leader of his people, from his cabinet to Parliament to the English subjects

who never considered defeat. You'll read about his good friend, Lord Beaverbrook, who kept the RAF running by building new planes from the salvaged parts of wrecked ones. You'll read about the elegant Clementine, who gave him unflinching support and plenty of space, their disappointing son Randolph, and unhappy daughter-in-law, Pam. You'll read about the teenage Churchill daughter, Mary, for whom the war was initially an exciting round of dances and parties with dashing young soldiers. And you'll read about Jack Colville, one of the private secretaries who kept a diary throughout his time with Churchill. You'll join the weekly caravans that took the Churchills and their many houseguests to their country home, Chequers, and listen in as the leaders of Great Britain plot strategy over drinks and dinner and drinks. You'll see the letters and telegrams exchanged between Churchill and Roosevelt as, ever so slowly, the prime minister makes headway with the president. And you'll also learn about Rudolf Hess, whose private peace mission to England went spectacularly, and comically, awry. And always, running in the background, is Hitler's progress across Europe, his growing domination of the Atlantic Ocean, and his decision to take on the Soviet Union before concentrating solely on England.

This is a long book and sometimes easy to put down. But after lying there on the table for a few hours, it always called me back. It is a wonderful portrait of a complex, flawed, driven man with a history of bad judgment calls who was exactly the right man to keep his countrymen on their feet and fighting when it seemed the whole world was kneeling.

The Importance of CURB APPEALS

Whether you have a small or large front porch, these small changes can make a big difference:


- · Start with a cleanup. Check for cobwebs and dead plants.

Well-maintained patio furniture with colorful accents is always inviting. Replacing faded or dirty cushions with soothing colors, such as cream or blue, then adding bright pops of color, like yellow or pink with pillows and matching accessories will look put-together and comfortable. With USA's Memorial Day, July 4, and Labor Day all coming up, a mixture of red, white, and blue accents will feel seasonal and festive.



- ½ teaspoon baking powder

• 2 eggs

• optional: powdered sugar/fruit for topping!

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°F. Grease and line an 8×8 baking tin with parchment paper. You can use baking spray or butter to grease.
- 2. Add your butter, sugar, chocolate, and syrup in a large bowl and melt either in the microwave or using a double boiler.
- 3. Once melted together, set aside to cool a little, so you don't cook your eggs in the next step.
- 4. Once cooled, mix in eggs one at a time and then vanilla and salt.
- 5. Sift in the flour, cocoa powder, and baking powder, then mix till all combined.
- 6. Pour the batter into your prepared tin and spread evenly.
- 7. Bake for around 20-25 minutes until set and when a toothpick is inserted, a few moist crumbs come out. The brownies may seem undercooked, but take them out when the edges are nice and brown.
- 8. Cool for about 10 minutes (unless you're really tempted) and add your toppings!
- 9. Cut into even squares or any shapes and share.



Pantone's 2020 Color of the Year was announced at the beginning of 2020, and this year's choice was Pantone 19-4052: Classic Blue. A gorgeous shade to be sure, Classic Blue brings to mind the sky at dusk, an elegant-yet-simple provocation of peace and tranquility. According to Laurie Pressman, vice president at the Pantone Color Institute, the color represents "our desire for a dependable and stable foundation from which to build as we cross the threshold into a new era... a reassuring presence, instilling calm, confidence, and connection." The choice is certainly apropos; between Mother Nature, the political stage, economic struggles, and COVID-19, it's been quite a year so far!

Accordingly, Pantone's Color of the Year choice, declared annually since 2000, is generally thought to capture the "spirit of the age," a rite of passage that sets the tone for the year ahead. Classic Blue certainly feels soothing in current times; just picture this serene, luxurious color on the walls of your bedroom, a tranquil refuge! Looking back, the very first Color of the Year in 2000 was Cerulean Blue, said to be the official color of the millennium, predicting peaceful and relaxing times to come in the face of angst about Y2K. For 2009, on the heels of the Great Recession and on the brink of great political change for our nation, Pantone declared its choice Mimosa, a warm yellow tone that spoke to the hope and optimism of the year ahead.

You might be wondering, as I was, what the significance is of the Color of the Year choice, beyond a sort of symbolic, abstract selection to reflect a global mood. In short, color drives consumerism. Each year, through a lengthy series of meetings - involving thoughtful consideration and trend analysis - between Pantone Color Institute and various global color standards groups, color influences from all over the world are examined, pulled from the realms of entertainment, art, fashion, design, social media, travel destinations, as well as new technologies, materials, and textures. Once a color is agreed upon (or two, as was the case in 2016), it becomes the new "it color," the backbone of numerous elaborate marketing campaigns, showing up everywhere from nail polish to cocktails to furniture colors. Indeed, 2020's Classic Blue was all over fashion runways for spring/summer 2020 collections and has shown up in décor choices for furniture, textiles, and even kitchen appliances! Perhaps our homes need a touch of calm endurance, a touch of blue, this year...


