### Vegan Chickpea Cheese:

- Nonstick baking spray
- + 3 and 1/2 cups plus 2 Tbsp water
- 1 cup plus 2 Tbsp chickpea or garbanzo bean flour
- 3 Tbsp nutritional yeast
- 3 Tbsp tapioca starch
- 1/4 tsp salt

# **PEA**-zza Pockets

### Crust

- 1 cup brown rice flour, plus more for dusting
- 1/2 cup sweet white sorghum flour
- + 3/4 cup plus 2 Tbsp potato or tapioca starch
- 1 and 1/4 tsp xanthan gum
- 2 tsp baking powder (gluten-free)
- 1/4 tsp baking soda
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 4 tsp olive oil
- + 1/2 cups plus 2 Tbsp plant milk (oat, rice, hemp, almond)
- 1/2 tsp apple cider vinegar

### **Tomato Sauce and Filling:**

- 5 Tbsp tomato paste
- 1/2 tsp oregano
- 1/2 tsp basil

. . .

- 1/2 tsp garlic powder
- Any desired toppings that aren't too watery (bell peppers, olives, sun-dried tomatoes, spinach, etc)

For the chickpea cheese: Spray a 9x5 inch loaf pan with baking spray. Add water to a large pot over medium-high heat. Bring water to boil and add remaining cheese ingredients and stir until thick and smooth. Turn off heat and pour cheese into prepared pan. Refrigerate until firm (approx. 5 hours), then shred. Keep shredded cheese refrigerated until ready to use.

For the crust: In a large mixing bowl, mix brown rice flour, sorghum flour, potato or tapioca starch, xantham gum, baking powder, baking soda, and salt. Add olive oil and mix until the flour has small pea-sized clumps. In a measuring cup, mix plant milk and apple cider vinegar, then add flour mixture. Stir with a fork until dough forms. Refrigerate until ready to assemble pockets.

For tomato sauce and filling: In a small bowl, mix the tomato paste, oregano, basil, and garlic powder, then set aside. Cut any desired filling into bite-sized pieces.

For assembly: Preheat oven to 425 degrees F. Line baking sheet with parchment paper and set aside. Lightly dust a cutting board with brown rice flour. Roll a 1/3 of dough into a 10x9 rectangle (dough thickness should not exceed 1/4"). Cut dough into 3 3x10" rectangles. Spread about 1/2 Tbsp of tomato paste into the middle of each rectangle. Add desired toppings and 1/4 cup of shredded chickpea cheese to half of each rectangle. Fold half of the dough over the filling and crimp edges with a fork to seal. Repeat this process with remaining dough and filling. Place pockets onto the baking sheet and bake for 15-20 minutes or until tops are golden brown. Serve and enjoy!

### resident book review

JARED DIAMOND

TURNING POINTS for NATIONS IN CRISIS

This is the third in a series of books by Jared Diamond in which he explores the reasons why nations rise and fall. In Guns, Germs, and Steel, he outlined how geography and natural resources (including native animals) affected the uneven development of civilization around the globe. And by the way, from this epic book, which I thoroughly enjoyed, the fact I remember most clearly is that from the vast array of mammals on this earth, we have managed to domesticate only 14! See if you can name them. For reasons you know if you have a kitty, cats don't count.

Collapse is a study of how external pressures, the misuse of natural resources, and just plain denial caused some seemingly successful societies to fail. Upheaval looks at six nations that experienced extreme crises and how their responses, like individual responses to life crises, changed them in small and profound ways but allowed them to survive.

The six nations in question are Finland, Japan, Chile, Indonesia, Germany, and Australia. Except for Japan, Diamond has lived in and speaks the languages of all of them. The crises felt by Finland and Japan were caused by pressure from outside. The crises that rocked Chile and Indonesia were created internally, and Germany and Australia suffered not from an immediate crisis, but the gradual build-up of intolerable situations. In each case, the crisis was resolved or is being resolved by applying many or all of the same tools that are used to overcome personal crises, as well as some that apply to nations but not individuals. Diamond also devoted two chapters to the growing crises in the United States, which have the potential to undermine American democracy. But he points out that the U.S. has the national memory of overcoming crises in the past and can do it again, using the same toolbox employed by the other nations.

## UPHEAVAL by Jared Diamond



The tools Diamond identifies for coping successfully with crises are:

- Acknowledging the problem
- Acceptance of responsibility to do something
- Isolating the problem to be solved
- Getting help
- Using others as models for solving the problem
- Ego strength (a sense of national identity)
- Honest self-appraisal
- Experience of previous crises
- Patience
- Adherence to core values
- Freedom from personal (or national) constraints

This is an interesting and informative book. I sometimes felt that maybe too much time was spent on peripheral or introductory material and then facts about the various national crises were kind of thrown out there very fast. But I quibble.

There are a number of questions inherent in this study of crises. Does a nation need a crisis in order to make changes? Do leaders make a difference? Can we actually learn from history? Will we?

We're halfway through 2020, and I'm sure most of us could use a little bit of relaxation. We may not be able to relax on a beach listening to crashing waves or spend the week at a spa, surrounded by a lush garden and beautiful fountains, but we can create that same serene setting in our own backyards. All you need is a little water.

The soothing sound of running water instantly brings a sense of relaxation to any setting, and there's a reason for that. In his book, Blue Mind: The Surprising Science That Shows How Being Near, In, On or Under Water Can Make You Happier, Healthier, More Connected, and Better at What You Do, author Wallace Nichols explains the science behind the serenity. According to Nichols, seeing and hearing water releases neurochemicals in your brain that promote wellness, and also increases your blood flow to both your heart and your brain, creating an immediate feeling of relaxation.

This sense of calm can be achieved in your own yard regardless of your budget, with an easy weekend DIY project or more elaborate landscaping.

You can create your own water feature in a single afternoon using a large ceramic pot and an inexpensive electric or solar-powered fountain. First, plug the hole at the bottom of the pot, place a large container upside down inside to fill most of the space, and put

the fountain on top. Then place stones from your yard around and over the container. Finally, fill the pot with water, and plug in the fountain. Done!

If you have the time and patience, you can also create a more elaborate water-scape. Susanne Braun, a resident of McCormick Woods since 2016, has made many improvements to her own backyard, designing and doing the work herself.

There was already a pond in place when she purchased her home, igniting her inspiration to create her own enchanted forest. Braun highlighted the natural, lush surroundings of our neighborhood with plants in a variety of shapes, heights, and different shades of green, and to top it off, the right lighting and décor. She brings attention to her water feature with a miniature bridge, and copper spinners add a little bit of that enchanted feel. This is not a one and done project. Braun has worked over the years to build this tranquil escape in her backyard, tying in something new every spring.

Interested in creating a similar space? Her number one piece of advice is to maintain a clear and pristine pond. Ensure that the design of the waterscape you choose allows for a rapid enough flow of water to allow for good algae control. It's also important to be diligent in cleaning the skimmer baskets and lower intake, or the flow of water decreases slightly and algae are harder to control.

Whatever your budget, yard size, or available time, adding a water feature to your lawn can help create a calm retreat and connect you with the wonderful forest surrounding us here in McCormick Woods.
